We travel by coach to **Hue** over the breathtaking **Hoi Van Pass**; visit the **Imperial City** and its ancient **citade**, the site of bitter fighting during the 1968 Tet Offensive. Compare the restrained ambience of ancient **Hanoi**, with its strong French connection, to bustling Saigon. Hanoi is a gracious, seductive city of tree-lined boulevards; an eclectic mix of French and Asian. Hanoi highlights will include a visit to the **Old Quarter** with its bustling cafes and shops, the infamous **Hanoi Hilton** and **Ho Chi Minh's house and gardens.** 

Explore the breathtaking World heritage site of **Ha long Bay**, its secluded bays and caves, and spend the night on the Bay on a five star cruise boat.

Travel by train to **Sapa**, near the **Chinese border**. This spectacular area is dominated by the **Hoang Lien Son Range, the eastern extremity of the Himalayas**. Ethnic minority tribes dominate this area. Highlights will be a visit to one of the most interesting and colourful markets in Asia and some easy walks through **H'mong villages**.
